

CHAPTER XXXIII.

A SUPPLEMENT

To the act, entitled "An act to provide for the erection of a State Penitentiary on the public land adjoining the town of Allegheny opposite Pittsburg, and for other purposes."

Commissioners to employ a clerk.

His salary.

SECT. 1. *BE it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That the commissioners appointed in pursuance of the provisions of the act to which this is a supplement, shall be, and they hereby are authorised to employ a clerk whose duty it shall be to take care of the books and papers, and perform such other duties as may be directed by the commissioners aforesaid; and the said clerk shall receive for his services such compensation as the commissioners may direct, not exceeding three hundred dollars per annum, and payable quarterly by the State Treasurer on certificates drawn by the commissioners aforesaid, out of the monies already appropriated by the act to which this is a supplement.

The height of the outer wall and towers of the penitentiary.

SECT. 2. *And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid,* That the height of the outer wall of the penitentiary from the surface of the ground shall be twenty-five feet, and the height of the towers thirty-five feet, any thing in the plan designated in the third section of the act to which this is supplementary, to the contrary notwithstanding.

CHAPTER XXXIV.

AN ACT

To limit the time of appeal in cases of divorce, and of the settlement of the accounts of guardians, executors and administrators.

SECT. 1. *BE it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General*

Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That no appeal shall lie from the final sentence or decree of the court of common pleas or other court having competent jurisdiction in cases of divorce, after the expiration of one year from the time of pronouncing the said final sentence or decree.

No appeal from the decree of the court in cases of divorce after one year.

SECT. 2. *And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid,* That when the accounts of guardians, executors or administrators shall be finally settled according to law, and the same confirmed by the court, no appeal shall lie therefrom unless the same be entered within one year after the said confirmation.

Nor from the confirmation of the accounts of guardians, &c after one year.

CHAPTER XXXV.

AN ACT

To confirm the title to certain real estate within this commonwealth to Benjamin Shaw, an alien.

SECT. 1. *BE it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same.* That the title to all the real estate which Benjamin Shaw, an alien, now holds by purchase, or which is held by others in trust for the said Benjamin, within this commonwealth, the right whereof still remains in him, be, and the same is hereby confirmed to him, his heirs and assigns, as fully and effectually as if he had been a citizen of the United States at the time the said purchase was made or the said trust accrued: *Provided,* That the right of no other person be hereby impaired.
