and for the said county of Warren.

Sect. 9. And be it further enacted by the authority afore-Sheriffs, &c. said, That the sheriffs, coroners and treasurers, of the said to give secu-county of Warren, before they enter on the duties of their offices, shall give security in like sums as similar officers do in the county of Crawford, and in the same manner and under the restrictions as similar officers are compelled to do in the several counties of this commonwealth.

CHAPTER LXXIII.

AN ACT
