

CHAPTER CIV.

*AN ACT*

For the relief of the heirs of Conrad Coderman, deceased, a soldier of the revolutionary war.

SECT. 1. *BE it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That the treasurer of the commonwealth be, and he hereby is directed to pay to the children and heirs at law of Conrad Coderman alias Conrad Catterman, deceased, three hundred dollars in full for a tract of donation land, to which the said Conrad Coderman was entitled for services rendered in the revolutionary war.

CHAPTER CV.

*AN ACT*

Authorising the Governor to appoint commissioners to lay out a state road from the borough of Marietta, in Lancaster county, to intersect the Middletown and Harrisburg Turnpike Road at or near the house of John Niessly in Dauphin county.

SECT. 1. *BE it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That the Governor be, and he is hereby authorised to appoint three disinterested commissioners, one of whom shall be a practical surveyor, to lay out and mark a state road from the borough of Marietta, in Lancaster county, in a direction towards Harrisburg, to intersect the Middletown and Harrisburg turapike road at or near the house of John Niessly in the county of Dauphin, the elevation of which road shall
