CHAPTER CXVI.

A SUPPLEMENT

To the act, entitled "An act to authorise the Governor to incorporate the President, Managers and Company of the Beaver and Greersburg Turnpike Road."

Sect. 1. BE it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same. That the time appointed by the act to which this is a Time for resupplement for opening the books and receiving subscriptions ceiving subfor stock in the Beaver and Greersburg turnpike road comscriptions expany, be, and the same is hereby extended to the first day of September next.

SECT. 2. And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid, That the said company shall have like powers, author-flaced on the ities and privileges necessary for carrying on and completing footing of the the said turnpike road, and be subject to all the duties, qual-Butler and ifications, restrictions, penalties, fines and forfeitures, and Mercer road be entitled to the like tolls and profits in proportion to the distance as are given and granted to the "Pittsburg, Butler and Mercer Turnpike Road Company."

SECT. 3. And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid, That Enoch Marvin and Guion Greer, be, and they are Additional hereby appointed additional commissioners to those mention-commissioned in the first section of the original act, to perform with said first appointed commissioners the several duties required of them by the said act.

SECT. 4. And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid, That so much of the act to which this is supplementary Repeal, as is hereby altered or supplied, be, and the same is hereby repealed.
