CHAPTER CLVII.

AN ACT

To facilitate the completion of the Allegheny bridge and the York and Gettysburg Turnpike road.

SECT. 1. BE it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That the Governor be, and he is hereby authorised and required to draw his warrant on the State Treasurer in favor of the president, managers and company for crecting a bridge over the Allegheny river opposite Pittsburg, in the county of Allegheny, for the sum of twenty thousand dollars, being the first instalment on sixteen hundred shares of the stock of

said company held by this commonwealth.

Secr. 2. And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid, That the money authorised to be subscribed on behalf of this commonwealth in the stock of the York and Gettysburg Turnpike road, shall instead of the mode heretofore prescribed, be payable as follows, one third thereof to be payable at the passing of this act, one third as soon as it shall be certified to the Governor by the managers that portions of said road are completed according to the contracts, amounting in the whole to two thirds of the whole road in extent, and the remaining third to be payable when the road shall be fully completed according to the requisitions of the act of incorporation; and the Governor is hereby authorised to draw his warrant on the State Treasurer in favor of said company accordingly.
