

CHAPTER XXVIII.

A SUPPLEMENT

To an act, entitled "An act incorporating the Presbyterian Congregation of Salem, in Derry township, in the county of Westmoreland."

SECT. 1. *BE it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That the trustees of Salem Congregation shall be five in number, and until others shall be elected shall consist of the following persons, viz. Hugh Culbertson, Uriah Matson, John Gallagher, James Guthrie and William Sterling, who shall continue in office until the first Tuesday of January, one thousand eight hundred and twenty one, on which day and on the same day of the same month every three years thereafter, the members of the said congregation shall at a general meeting thereof, elect by ballot five persons to serve as trustees to continue in office three years thereafter; and if any vacancy by death or otherwise shall happen in the board of trustees, the remaining trustees may and they are hereby required to elect one or more persons to supply such vacancy until the next triennial election in said congregation: *Provided nevertheless,* That if it should happen that at any future time an election should not be held on the day above mentioned, it shall be lawful for the congregation aforesaid to elect at a future day to be agreed upon by the trustees.

SECT. 2. *And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid,* That the second section of the act to which this is a supplement be and the same is hereby repealed.
