CHAPTER L.

A SUPPLEMENT

To the act, entitled "An act for taking lands in execution for payment of debts."

Inquest on dispensed with by defendant.

Sect. 1. BE it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That the inquest required by the second and third seclands may be tions of the act to which this is a supplement, shall be dispensed with whenever the defendant or defendants, being at the time of issuing the execution the owner or owners of the lands and tenements, by writing filed in the proper court, shall agree, or when any owner or owners of lands shall have heretofore agreed as aforesaid, to dispense with and wave the same, and that all sales made heretofore, or which hereafter shall be made under any writs of venditioni exponas, in such cases shall be as good and available in law, as if such inquest had been held and the clear profits of such lands and tenements had been adjudged insufficient to pay within seven years, the debts and damages due thereon, agreeably to the provisions of the act of Assembly in such cases made and provided.
