CHAPTER LVII. *A SUPPLEMENT*

To an act entitled "An act, to re-annex part of Mifflin county to the county of Union," passed the sixteenth day of March, one thousand eight hundred and nineteen.

SECT. 1. BE it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That one of the county commissioners of the county of Mifflin, and one of the county commissioners of the county of Union, shall meet on a day agreed upon by them in May next, and shall employ a skilful surveyor to run and mark in a plain manner, a line agreeably to the provisions of the act to which this is a supplement, and make two drafts of the said lines with the courses and distances marked thereon, which shall be delivered to the clerks of the courts of quarter sessions of the respective counties, who are hereby required to file the the same in their respective offices, to be and remain the division line between the countles of Mifflin and Union; and the expenses necessarily incurred in running and marking said line, shall be paid equally by warrants drawn by the commissioners of Mifflin and Union counties, on their respec-

tive county treasuries in the usual manner.

Secr. 2. And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid.
