

CHAPTER LIX.

AN ACT

To increase the number of constables, in Washington and Cumberland counties.

Additional constables to be elected in Nottingham, Washington.

SECT. 1. *BE it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That the electors of the township of Nottingham, in the county of Washington, shall annually on the day appointed for the election of constables in the different townships in this Commonwealth, hereafter elect four suitable persons inhabitants of said township, and return the names of the persons so elected to the next general court of quarter sessions to be held for the county of Washington, two of whom shall be appointed constables for the said township, in the same manner, with like powers and authority, and subject to the same regulations and penalties as are provided and contained in the several laws of this Commonwealth relating to constables.

Four persons to be returned.

SECT. 2. *And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid,* That from and after the passing of this act, the electors residing within the township of Newton, in the county of Cumberland, shall annually, on the same day and at the same place where they meet to choose supervisors of the highways, elect four reputable citizens in said township and return the names of the persons so elected to the next court of quarter sessions of said county, and the said court shall appoint two of them to be constables for the aforesaid township, conformably to law, any law, usage or custom to the contrary notwithstanding.

Additional constables in Tyrone, Cumberland.

SECT. 3. *And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid,* That from and after the passing of this act, the electors residing within the township of Tyrone, in the county of Cumberland, shall annually, on the same day and at the same place where they meet to choose supervisors of the highways, elect four reputable citizens in said township, and return the names of the persons so elected to the next court of quarter sessions of said county, and the said court shall appoint two of them to be constables for the aforesaid township, conformably to law, any law usage or custom to the contrary notwithstanding.
