

and terms, any thing in this act to the contrary notwithstanding.

SECT. 6. *And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid,* That the said works for carrying and conveying the water into the town aforesaid, shall be completed in three years from and after the passing of this act.

SECT. 7. *And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid,* That if at any time after the expiration of twenty years from and after the passing of this act, the citizens of Milford should be disposed to purchase the said water works and privileges, they shall have a right so to do, for such price as shall be fixed by seven judicious and disinterested persons, or a majority of them, to be appointed by the Court of Quarter Sessions of the county of Pike, who shall be under oath or affirmation; and upon the payment of the price so fixed, all the rights, privileges and franchises hereby granted, shall be vested in the citizens of the said town of Milford.

CHAPTER XCII.

*A SUPPLEMENT*

To the act, entitled "An act to incorporate the city of Philadelphia."

SECT. 1. *BE it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That the Recorder of the city of Philadelphia shall annually receive out of the State Treasury the sum of nine hundred dollars, to be paid quarterly, as a compensation for his services.
