

be demanded from the said James Hopkins, and if he shall refuse or neglect to cause the same to be paid into the State Treasury within twenty days after such demand made, the Auditor General is hereby required to direct the Attorney General, or his deputy, to bring suit in the name of the Commonwealth against the said James Hopkins, to be recovered as other debts of equal amount are by law recoverable. The amount of the expense to be demanded and sued for from James Hopkins.

CHAPTER CIII.

*AN ACT*

Authorising and requiring the Accountant Officers to settle and adjust the account of Archibald S. Jordan.

SECT. 1. *BE it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That the Accountant Officers be, and they are hereby required to settle and adjust the account of Archibald S. Jordan, inspector of the first brigade of the fifth division of Pennsylvania militia, for extra services rendered under the Governor's order of the sixteenth March, one thousand eight hundred and fifteen, and to admit and allow the charges therein made, so far as they may think the same reasonable and proper; and the amount found due shall be paid by the State Treasurer, in the usual manner.
