CHAPTER CXVII.

A FURTHER SUPPLEMENT

To an act, entitled "A further supplement to an act, entitled, an act to incorporate a company for making an artificial road from Harrisburg through Lewistown and Huntingdon to Pittsburg," passed the twenty sixth day of February, one thousand eight hundred and sixteen.

Sect. 1. BE it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That the Governor be, and he is hereby authorised and Governer to required to subscribe to the stock of the Huntingdon, Cam-subscribe bria and Indiana turnpike road company, the sum of six thou. \$ 6,850: sand eight hundred and fifty dollars, to be applied by said company to the making of that section of said road lying between the town of Alexandria and the borough of Huntingdon, in the county of Huntingdon, which said sum shall be deemed and taken as the proportional part of the sum of sixty thousand dollars, authorised to be subscribed on the part of the state for the section of said road lying between the town of Alexandria aforesaid and Millerstown in the county of Cumberland, to be paid in the same manner and under the same restrictions as prescribed in the second section of the act, entitled "A further supplement to the act, entitled, an act authorising the Governor to incorporate a company for making an artificial road from the borough of Harrisburg, through Lewistown and Huntingdon to Pittsburg," passed the twenty-fourth of March one thousand eight hundred and twelve: Provided, That the said company shall not be obliged to finish five miles of said section from Alexan-Proviso. dria to Huntingdon before they shall be entitled to draw any money from the state, but that on finishing the last section of ten miles between the town of Alexandria aforesaid and the crossing of the Big Conemaugh river, the said sum of six thousand eight hundred and fifty dollars shall be paid to the said company in advance, as has been done on completing any previous ten miles.
