CHAPTER VI.

AN ACT

Reducing the salaries of sundry public officers and the daily pay of members of the Legislature.

Sect. 1. BE it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That from and after the passage of this act, the act en-The act of titled "A further supplement to the act, entitled, an act to 1814 repealprovide for the support of the government of this common-cd, wealth," passed the seventh day of February one thousand eight hundred and fourteen, increasing the per diem allow-except as to ance and mileage of the members of the legislature, be, and mileage. the same is hereby repealed, excepting so far as respects the mileage.

SECT. 2. And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid, That the pay of the clerks of the Senate and House of Pay of the Representatives respectively, shall be three hundred dollars clerks and per annum and four dollars a day during the session; and assistant the pay of the assistant clerks shall be one hundred and fifty clerks, dollars per annum and four dollars a day each, during the

session, and no more.

Sect. 3. And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid, That the sergeants at arms and door-keepers respectively shall receive one hundred dollars per annum and two And of the dollars a day during the session; and the assistant door-keep-arms and ers each one dollar and fifty cents a day, which shall be in door keepfull for their services, any law or usage heretofore to the con-crs. trary notwithstanding.

SECT. 4. And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid, That the salaries of the Auditor General, Surveyor General, State Treasurer and Secretary of the Land Office, Salaries of shall be respectively one thousand four hundred dollars per cers of the annum payable quarterly; and the salary of the deputy Secre-government tary of the Commonwealth shall be one thousand dollars per fixed. annum payable quarterly.

SECT. 5. And be it further enacted by the authority afore- Attorney said, That the salary of the Attorney General shall be three General.

hundred dollars per annum, payable quarterly.

Secr. 6. And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid, That from and after the first day of April next the Pay of the commissioners and auditors of the several counties within commissionthis commonwealth, shall respectively be entitled to receive ers and audiout of the county treasuries the sum of one dollar and fifty tors. cents per diem and no more, for every day they shall necessarily attend to their respective duties, except in the city and county of Philadelphia, where the pay of the commissioners shall be three dollars per diem and the pay of the auditors

two dollars per diem, and the treasurer of said county of Philadelphia shall receive for his services an annual salary of twelve hundred dollars and no more.

Repeal of part of a former law.

SECT. 7. And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid, That so much of any former law as is hereby altered and supplied, be, and the same is hereby repealed.

CHAPTER VII.
