CHAPTER XXIII.

A SUPPLEMENT

To the act, entitled "An act for incorporating the German Lutheran congregation in and near the borough of Lancaster, in the state of Pennsylvania."

SECT. 1. BE it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same. That the members of the congregation of the German Lutheran church in the city, (formerly borough) of Lancaster, duly qualified to elect officers of the said church, be, and Authorised they are hereby authorised and empowered to elect three to elect three church wardens, in addition to the present number, at their church warnext annual election, one of whom shall be elected for one dens. year, one for two years, and the remaining one for three years; and the corporation of the minister, trustees, elders Corporation. and church wardens of the congregation aforesaid, shall hereafter consist of the minister or ministers of the said congregation, duly chosen from time to time, and of three trustees, nine elders and nine church wardens, and one third part in number of the elders and church wardens shall cease and discontinue, and their appointments determine as heretofore on the Easter Monday in every year, when a new election shall be had and held of an equal number in their places and stead.

SECT. 2. And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid, That so much of the act to which this is a supplement Repeal as is hereby altered, be, and the same is hereby repealed.
