CHAPTER XXVII.

AN ACT

To annul the marriage contract of James Allen and Jane his wife.

SECT. 1. BE it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That the marriage contract entered into between James Allen and Jane his wife, late Jane Hunter, of Fayette county, be, and the same is hereby annulled and made void, and the parties released from the said contract and from all legal duties and obligations arising therefrom, as fully and effectually to all intents and purposes as if they never had been joined in marriage.

CHAPTER XXVIII.

A SUPPLEMENT
