CHAPTER XXX.

AN ACT

For the relief of Jefferson, Washington and Allegheny Colleges.

Sect. 1. BE it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That the State Treasurer be, and he is hereby authorised and directed to pay the trustees of Jefferson college, or order, the sum of one thousand dollars annually for five years, to commence on the first of January, one thousand eight hundred and twenty.

Jefferson college.

Washington college.

Secr. 2. And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid. That the State Treasurer be, and he is hereby authorised and directed to pay to the trustees of Washington college, or order, the sum of one thousand dollars annually for five years, to commence on the first day of January, eighteen

hundred and twenty.

Allegheny college.

SECT. 3. And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid, That the State Treasurer be, and he is hereby authorised and directed to pay to the trustees of Allegheny college, or order, the sum of one thousand dollars annually for five years, to commence on the first day of January, one thousand eight hundred and twenty.

CHAPTER XXXI.

A FURTHER SUPPLEMENT

To the act, entitled "An act laying a tax on dogs in certain counties, and for other purposes."

SECT. 1. BE it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General
