

CHAPTER XLI.

*AN ACT*

For the relief of sundry old soldiers.

SECT. 1. *BE it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That the State Treasurer be, and he is hereby authorised and required to pay to Joseph Reed, of Washington county, Jacob Balmer, of Lancaster county, William M'Fadden, of Crawford county, and to John Morrison, of Huntingdon county, or their respective orders, the sum of forty dollars each, immediately after the passing of this act, and an annuity of forty dollars each, to commence on the first day of January, eighteen hundred and twenty-one, and to be paid half yearly during life.*

CHAPTER XLII.

*AN ACT*

To erect the town of Berlin in Somerset county, into a borough.

SECT. 1. *BE it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That the town of Berlin, in the county of Somerset, shall be, and the same is hereby erected into a borough, which shall be called the borough of Berlin, which borough shall be comprised within the following boundaries, to wit: Beginning at a stone in the line of the old town of Berlin,* Borough erected.
