

## CHAPTER LXXXVIII.

*AN ACT*

Supplementary to an act, entitled "An act to incorporate the township of Moyamensing, in Philadelphia county," passed the twenty-fourth March, one thousand eight hundred and twelve.

Repeal

Collectors to  
pay over monies received  
&c.

SECT. 1. *BE it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That so much of the eighteenth section of an act, entitled "An act to incorporate the township of Moyamensing, in Philadelphia county," passed the twenty-fourth day of March, one thousand eight hundred and twelve, as allows the collectors of taxes appointed by the commissioners of said township to deduct five per cent. from monies collected by them, as a compensation for the collection thereof, be, and the same is hereby repealed, and in lieu thereof the said collectors shall in future pay over all such monies as are directed in the said eighteenth section of the said act, deducting therefrom such sums only as shall have been agreed upon at the time of their appointment.

SECT. 2. *And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid,* That for the better protection and government of the said township of Moyamensing, in addition to any officers already provided for, there shall be such other police officer or officers appointed therein, and at such salaries or other compensation as the commissioners shall direct, which said officer or officers hereby provided for, before entering on their duties shall take a solemn oath or affirmation well and faithfully to perform and execute the same.
