CHAPTER CLX.

AN ACT

For the relief of Daniel Sharp.

SECT. 1. *BE it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That the accountant officers of this commonwealth, be, and they are hereby authorised and required to settle and adjust the accounts of Daniel Sharp, inspector of the first brigade, first division, Pennsylvania militia, and for this purpose to open the accounts of the said Daniel Sharp wherein the same are closed, so far as is necessary to carry this act into effect: Provided, That this act shall not be so construed as to authorise the accountant officers aforesaid, to allow to the said Daniel Sharp any credit for money paid by him for fees of aldermen in the collection of militia fines, as exhibited in his accounts to the Auditor General, in the year one thousand eight hundred and seventeen.*
