AN ACT

To extend the charter of the Commercial bank of Pennsylvania.

SECT. 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That the act, entitled "An act to re-charter certain banks," approved the twenty-fifth day of March, one thousand eight hundred and twenty-four, be and the same is hereby extended for and during the term of ten years, from and after the first Wednesday in May, one thousand eight hundred and thirty-five, so far as the provisions of said act relate to the Commercial bank of Pennsylvania: *Provided* ^{Extended ten years from May, 1835.} *nevertheless,* That said bank shall be subject to such alterations, provisions and restrictions, as the legislature may at any time hereafter think proper to enact for the better regulating of the banking institutions of this commonwealth; and also to all requisitions as to a bonus or premium to be paid to the commonwealth, as a consideration for the privileges herein granted, as now by law are demanded, or as the legislature may at any time hereafter demand. ^{Proviso.} ^{Subject to restrictions, requisitions, &c.}

SECT. 2. *And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid,* That from and after the first day of December next, no officer in said bank, except the president and directors, shall be permitted to own, either directly or indirectly, any share or shares of the capital stock of said bank, under pain of forfeiture of all stock so held to and for the use of the said bank. ^{After 1st December certain officers not to hold stock.}

AN ACT

Erecting all that part of Mifflin county, south and east of the Black Log and Shade mountains, into a separate county, to be called Juniata.

SECT. 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That all that part of Mifflin county, laying south and east of a line, beginning on the summit of Black Log moun-
