## AN ACT

Authorising the election of an additional constable for the township of Buffalo, in the county of Armstrong.

SECT. 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That from and after the passage of this act, it shall <sup>2 to be chosen</sup> and may be lawful for the qualified electors of Buffalo <sup>out of 4 elect.</sup> township, Armstrong county, to elect, annually, at their <sup>ed.</sup> usual place of electing township officers, four qualified citizens for constables, two of whom shall be appointed by the court of quarter sessions of said county, to serve as constables for said township, subject to the same rules and regulations as constables are now by law regulated.

## AN ACT

To authorise the Governor to incorporate the president, managers and company of the Dundaff and Honesdale turnpike road.
