## AN ACT

Changing the time of holding the elections of the New Alexandria and Conemaugh, and New Alexandria and Pittsburg turnpike road company.

SECT. 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That the stockholders of the New Alexandria and Conemaugh, and New Alexandria and Pittsburg turnpike company, shall after the first day of March next, elect their managers on the first Monday of January, one thousand eight hundred and thirty-two, and annually thereafter.

To first Monday of January.

SECT. 2. *And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid,* That so much of the act passed the tenth of April, eighteen hundred and twenty-six, entitled A supplement to the act, entitled An act relative to turnpike road and bridge companies, in which the state holds stock, as relates to the companies aforesaid, as is hereby altered, be and the same is hereby repealed.

## A FURTHER SUPPLEMENT

To the act, entitled "An act for the regulation of the militia of this commonwealth," passed the second of April, eighteen hundred and twenty-two, so far as relates to the Union Greys, of Wrightsville, in York county.

SECT. 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That the act prescribing that volunteer companies, not attached to a volunteer battalion, shall be attached to
