AN ACT

To alter the boundaries of the borough of Jersey Shore, in the county of Lycoming.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same.* That from and after the passage of this act, the boundaries of the borough of Jersey Shore, in the county of Lycoming, shall be as follows: beginning on the west branch of the Susquehanna river, at low water mark, at the corner of land of Richard Webb and Jacob W. Pfouts; thence along the line of Richard Webb and Jacob W. Pfouts, and land of Thomas Calvert north eighty-one degrees, west eighty-four perches, to a post, a corner of William B. Smith; thence along the same, north thirteen degrees, east forty-two perches, to a post, a corner of Abraham Lawshe's lot; thence along the same, north seventy-seven degrees, west twenty-six perches, to a post; thence along the same, north thirteen degrees, east thirty perches, to a public road, leading to the house of James Nichols; thence along lands of Abraham Lawshe and James Wilson, north eighteen degrees, east thirty-nine perches, to a post on the line of John Slonecker; thence along the same, south seventy-two degrees, east thirty-four perches, to a post; thence over lands of the said John Slonecker, north seventeen degrees, east sixty-one perches, to a post on the line of Robert Maffet; thence over land of Robert Maffet, south sixty-six degrees, east thirty-three perches, to low water mark; thence up the river, the several courses and distances thereof, to the place of beginning.

SECT. 2. *And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid,* That so much of the several acts incorporating the borough of Jersey Shore, and extending the boundaries thereof, as are hereby altered or supplied, be and the same is hereby repealed.
