RESOLUTION

Relative to the protection and repair of the capitol and public offices, and improvement of the adjoining public ground.

Resolved, by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, in General Assembly met, That the Secretary of the Land Office, the Clerk of the Senate, and the Clerk of the House of Representatives, be and they are hereby appointed commissioners, whose duty it shall be, during the ensuing recess of the legislature, to cause the outside of the state capitol to be painted, as far as may be necessary; and also to cause all needful and proper repairs to be done to said capitol, and to the adjoining public offices; and that the sum of one thousand dollars be, and the same is hereby appropriated, for the purposes aforesaid, to be drawn from the state treasury, on warrants of the Governor of the commonwealth, in favor of the said commissioners. Commissioners appointed to have capitol and offices painted and repaired. \$1,000 appropriated.

And be it further resolved, That the sum of four hundred and ninety-six dollars ninety-eight cents, be, and the same is hereby appropriated, to enable "the commissioners appointed to superintend the public ground attached to the state capitol," to settle with the contractors employed by them, and that the said sum be drawn from the state treasury, on a warrant or warrants of the Governor of the commonwealth, in favor of the said commissioners. \$496 98 appropriated to pay contractors for enclosing public ground.
