RESOLUTION

Relative to a Canal and Lock communication between the Pennsylvania Canal and the Juniata river, opposite the mouth of Tuscarora creek.

Resolved by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met,
 That the Canal Commissioners are hereby authorised and required, as soon as conveniently may be, to cause a survey, plan and estimate to be made, of a canal and lock communication, between the Pennsylvania canal and the Juniata river, at, or nearly opposite the mouth of the Tuscarora creek, and report said survey, plan and estimate to the next Legislature.
