Rossiter had or held at the time of his death, in the aforesaid tract of fifty acres of land, be the same more or less, and to make, execute, acknowledge and deliver, a good and sufficient deed or deeds for the same to the purchaser or purchasers thereof, his, her, or their heirs and assigns forever: *Provided*, That the said administratrix, previous to such sale, give bond in the Orphans' court of Chester county, with two sureties, to be approved by the said court, in double the estimated value of the land, conditioned for the faithful application of the purchase money.

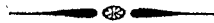

### AN ACT

For the relief of Mary Welsh, the widow of a revolutionary soldier.

SECT. 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That the state treasurer be and he is hereby authorised and required to pay to Mary Welsh, of Butler county, the widow of a revolutionary soldier, or to her order, forty dollars immediately, and an annuity of forty dollars payable half yearly, during life, to commence on the first day of January, one thousand eight hundred and thirty-two.
