

unless he shall have been a member of the congregation six years preceding the time of his election and paid for a pew or sitting in said church during that period.

SECT. 2. *And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid,* That the said corporation shall hereafter be known by the name, style and title of "the trustees, elders and deacons of the German Reformed congregation in the city of Philadelphia, in the state of Pennsylvania," and by the said name shall have, hold and enjoy all lands, tenements and hereditaments, grants, bequests or gifts, whatsoever, now holden, or to which the said corporation under the title of "the minister, trustees, elders and deacons of the German Reformed congregation of the city of Philadelphia, in the province of Pennsylvania," would be entitled to hold.

SECT. 3. *And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid,* That so much of the said letters patent so granted as aforesaid, as are hereby altered or supplied, be and the same hereby are repealed.

AN ACT

To open and improve part of a state road from Samuel Hill's, in Greene county, Pennsylvania, to Middlebourne, Virginia.

WHEREAS the legislature of Virginia, at their last session, appropriated five thousand dollars to open and improve the state road aforesaid, on the Virginia side, on condition that an appropriation should be made for completing that part which lies within the state of Pennsylvania: Therefore,

SECT. 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That the sum of two thousand, five hundred dollars, be and the same is hereby appropriated to be paid to David

\$2,500 appropriated to Greene co. portion of road.

Sellars, Asa McClelland and Samuel Morris, on warrants drawn by the Governor on the treasurer of this commonwealth, and shall be expended by them in opening so much of the state road leading from Samuel Hill's in Franklin township, Greene county, Pennsylvania, to Middlebourne, Virginia, as lies in Greene county aforesaid, and the said commissioners shall be allowed one dollar and fifty cents each for every day necessarily spent in performance of the duties required of them by this section, to be paid out of the county treasury for said county, on account settled, certified and approved of and signed by the auditors of said county.

Compensation of commissioners.

SECT. 2. *And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid,* That before the said commissioners shall draw the money hereby appropriated they shall enter into bond to the commonwealth with one or more sureties, to be approved of by one of the judges of the court of common pleas of the county of Greene, for the faithful and judicious expenditure of said money.

Sureties of commissioners.

SECT. 3. *And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid,* That the said commissioners shall, as soon as the said money is expended, make report to the court of Quarter Sessions of the county of Greene, and upon such report so made, the court is hereby directed to appoint three citizens of said county, whose duty it shall be to view said road, and make report of the same to said court, particularly setting forth whether or not said money was judiciously expended, agreeably to the provisions of this act, and if the report shall be approved by the said court, then and in that case, the said bond shall be null and void, for which service they shall be allowed one dollar and fifty cents per day, to be paid out of the county treasury aforesaid.

Appointment of viewers.

Their report and compensation.

SECT. 4. *And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid,* That immediately after the passage of this act, the Governor of this Commonwealth be and he is hereby requested, to transmit to the Governor of Virginia a certified copy of this act.
