## AN ACT

For the relief of Magdalena Horn and Nancy Clark, widows of revolutionary soldiers.

*SECT. 1. Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That the State Treasurer be and he is hereby authorised and required to pay to Magdalena Horn, of York county, the widow of a revolutionary soldier, or to her order, forty dollars immediately, and an annuity of forty dollars, payable half yearly, to commence on the first day of January, one thousand eight hundred and thirty-two.*

*SECT. 2 And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid, That the State Treasurer be and he is hereby authorised and required to pay to Nancy Clark, of Guernsey county, in the state of Ohio, the widow of a revolutionary soldier, or to her order, forty dollars as a gratuity.*

## A SUPPLEMENT

To the act entitled An act for laying out certain state roads in Schuylkill, Northampton, Butler, Luzerne, Lycoming, Chester and Bucks counties, and for other purposes.

*SECT. 1. Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That all the provisions and limitations of the above recited act, so far as respects the state road from the town of Tamaqua, in the county of Schuylkill, through Panther*
