AN ACT

Directing the time of closing the reports and accounts of the Canal Commissioners, and the reports of the Commissioners of the Internal Improvement fund.

SECT. 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That the annual reports directed by law to be made of the canal commissioners, of the commissioners of the internal improvement fund, and the settlement of the accounts of the canal commissioners by the auditor general, shall hereafter be closed on the thirty-first day of October in each and every year.

AN ACT

Relative to the Belmont and Easton turnpike road.

Costs of suits
for penalties.

SECT. 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That whenever hereafter "The president managers and company of the Belmont and Easton turnpike road" shall sue for and recover the penalty or penalties prescribed by law against any person or persons evading or attempting to evade the payment of tolls on the said road, they shall also recover their costs of suit,
