AN ACT

To change the names of Phillip William Burgholthous, Anthony Daniel Burgholthous and Barnard Henry Burgholthous of the county of York.

SECT. 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That Philip William Burgholthous be and he is hereby authorised to change his name from Philip William Burgholthous, to that of Philip William Burg, and he shall henceforth be called and known by the name of Philip William Burg, and by the same name shall be able and capable in law to sue and be sued, grant and receive, and do all other legal acts as effectually to all intents and purposes as he could have done by his former name if no change had been made therein. SECT. 2. *And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid,* That Anthony Daniel Burgholthous be and he is hereby authorised to change his name from Anthony Daniel Burgholthous to that of Anthony Daniel Burg, and he shall henceforth be called and known by the name of Anthony Daniel Burg, and by the same name shall be able and capable in law to sue and be sued, grant and receive, and do all other legal acts as effectually to all intents and purposes as he could have done by his former name if no change had been made therein. SECT. 3. *And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid,* That Barnard Henry Burgholthous be and he is authorised to change his name from Barnard Henry Burgholthous to that of Barnard Henry Burg and he shall from henceforth be called and known by the name of Barnard Henry Burg, and by the same name shall be able and capable in law to sue and be sued, grant and receive, and shall do all other legal acts as effectually to all intents and purposes as he could have done by his former name if no change had been made therein.
