## AN ACT

To extend the time for completing the Washington and Pittsburg turnpike road, and to legalize the appointment of treasurer by the board of managers.

Extension of time allowed in former acts, one year.

SECT. 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That the time allowed in the act entitled "An act authorising the Governor to incorporate the Washington and Pittsburg turnpike road company," passed the twenty-fifth day of March, one thousand eight hundred and seventeen, for the completion of the said road, and the acts for the extension of the charter of said company, passed the twentieth of March eighteen hundred and twenty-seven, and the nineteenth of March, eighteen hundred and twenty-nine, be and the same is hereby extended, for the term of one year from the twentieth day of March next, and the charter of the said company and the several laws relative thereto or in any manner concerning the said company, which are now in force, shall be and remain in as full force as though the time extended in this act had been allowed in the original act.

Acts of John Watson as treasurer legalized.

SECT. 2. *And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid,* That all the official acts of John Watson, who has been appointed by the president and managers of the Washington and Pittsburg turnpike road company, treasurer pro tempore in the room of their late treasurer, deceased, done and performed by him the said John Watson, as treasurer of said company, or that may be done and performed by him from the tenth day of November, eighteen hundred and thirty-one, until the ninth day of April, eighteen hundred and thirty-two, be and the same are hereby declared legal and valid, so far as they may have been illegal or invalid by reason of his being appointed instead of elected, and shall be so regarded in all courts of justice within this commonwealth, and elsewhere, to all intents and purposes as if he the said John Watson had been duly and legally elected to the office of treasurer by the said company, and in case of the death or resignation of the treasurer of said company, at any subsequent time, the president and managers shall have power to appoint a suitable person to act in that capacity until their next annual election.
