## AN ACT

For the relief of Dieter Snyder and John Moser soldiers of the revolutionary war.

SECT. 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That the State Treasurer be and he is hereby authorised and required to pay to Dieter Snyder, of Schuylkill county, a soldier of the revolution, or order, forty dollars <sup>\$40 gratuity and annuity to</sup> immediately and an annuity of forty dollars, payable half <sup>D. Snyder.</sup> yearly, to commence on the first day of January, one thousand eight hundred and thirty-two.

SECT. 2. *And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid,* That the State Treasurer be and he is hereby authorised and <sup>Same to J. Moser.</sup> required to pay to John Moser, of Butler county, a soldier of the revolution, or order, forty dollars immediately, and an annuity of forty dollars, payable half yearly, to commence on the first day of January, one thousand eight hundred and thirty-two.

For the relief of Agnes Vaughn, the widow of a soldier of the revolutionary war.

SECT. 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That the State Treasurer is hereby authorised and <sup>\$40 gratuity and annuity to</sup> required to pay to Agnes Vaughn, of Mercer county, the <sup>A. Vaughn.</sup> widow of a soldier of the revolution, or to her order, forty

dollars immediately, and an annuity of forty dollars during life, payable half yearly, to commence on the first day of January, eighteen hundred and thirty-two,

A SUPPLEMENT

To an act entitled An act granting authority to purchase real estate with certain moneys of Samuel Dickson McCloy, a minor, and authorising the guardian of John Evans, a minor, to purchase certain real estate, passed the twelfth day of April, one thousand eight hundred and twenty-eight.

SECT. 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That all the powers granted by the first section of the act to which this is a supplement, to the guardian of Samuel Dickson McCloy, a minor, are hereby transferred to Jeremiah Emery and Ebenezer McClelland, of Washington county, the present guardians of said minor: *Provided,* That the Orphans' court of Washington county shall exercise the same powers as is provided in the act to which this is supplementary, to be exercised by the Orphans' court of Lancaster county.
