AN ACT

Establishing the boundary line between Venango and Jefferson counties.

WHEREAS, it has been represented to the Legislature, that Preamble. owing to a number of difficulties and inconveniences arising between the counties of Venango and Jefferson, from the uncertainty as to the particular location of the boundary line between said counties, an arrangement was made between the respective commissioners of said counties, in pursuance of which Richard Irwin, Esquire, did, in the month of September A. D. one thousand eight hundred and thirty, run and mark the boundary line between said counties, to the entire satisfaction of both counties: Therefore,

SECT. 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That the said boundary line between the counties Irwin's line of Venango and Jefferson, as run and marked by the said confirmed. Richard Irwin, be and the same is hereby confirmed and established as the boundary between said counties; and upon the said Richard Irwin's filing a draft of the said running in each of the Commissioners' Offices of the said counties, (if not already done before the passage of this act) it shall and Draughts to be filed. may be lawful for the commissioners of said counties to settle and adjust the accounts of the said Richard Irwin, for Settlement of accounts. the trouble and expenses of running said boundary line, by warrants drawn on their treasurers respectively, in equal proportions.

AN ACT

Relative to the election of Auditors in the borough of Allegheny, in the county of Allegheny.

SECT. 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That from and after the passage of this act, it shall

and may be lawful for the qualified electors of the borough of Allegheny, in the county of Allegheny, to elect auditors for said borough, at the same time and place when and where they are now authorised by law to elect borough officers; and that so much of any other law as is hereby altered or supplied, be and the same is hereby repealed.

AN ACT

Authorising the erection of a bridge over Raccoon creek, on or near the dividing line of the counties of Washington and Beaver.

SECT. 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That the commissioners of the counties of Washington and Beaver be, and they are hereby authorised, if they shall deem it necessary and expedient, to build and construct a bridge over Raccoon creek, on or near the dividing line of the said counties, at the joint expense of the same, in such manner as travellers and others passing and repassing on the state road from the Virginia state line to Pittsburg, may be better accommodated: *Provided* the same be undertaken and commenced within two years from the passage of this act.
