AN ACT

To confer on Hannah Withers the rights and benefits of a child born in lawful wedlock.

SECT. 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same*, That Hannah Withers, late Hannah Senseman, a daughter of Joseph Senseman and Nancy Senseman, of the county of Lancaster, and born some time before the marriage of the said Joseph and Nancy Senseman, shall have and enjoy all the rights, benefits and advantages of a child born in lawful wedlock, and shall be able and capable in law to inherit and transmit any estate whatsoever, as fully and completely, to all intents and purposes, as if she had been born subsequently to the intermarriage of her aforesaid parents: *Provided*, That nothing in this act shall be construed to interfere with the rights or interest which this commonwealth may have under a law entitled "An act relative to collateral inheritances." *Proviso.* *Collateral in- heritances.* *Late Hannah Senseman.*
