AN ACT

Supplementary to an act to authorize the Governor to incorporate a company for erecting a permanent bridge over the river Susquehanna, at or near Harrisburg, in the county of Dauphin, and a further supplement to the several acts incorporating a company to make a turnpike from the Northern termination of the York and Conewago turnpike road, to the west end of the Harrisburg bridge.

Preamble.

WHEREAS, on the thirtieth day of April, one thousand eight hundred and thirty-one, a resolution was passed by the president, directors and company, for erecting a permanent bridge over the river Susquehanna, at or near the borough of Harrisburg, authorizing the president of the said company to subscribe for stock in the York Haven and Harrisburg bridge and turnpike road company, in behalf of said bridge company: *And whereas,* The interest of said bridge company would be greatly promoted by the increase of travelling over the same, which must necessarily take place on the completion of said turnpike road: Therefore,

SECT. 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That the president of the said Harrisburg bridge company is hereby authorized to subscribe on behalf of said company, for such number of shares of stock on the books of the commissioners of the York Haven and Harrisburg bridge turnpike road company, as the board of directors of the

said institution may direct, not exceeding in amount three thousand five hundred dollars.

SECT. 2. *And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid,* That the name, style and title of the said president, directors and company for erecting a permanent bridge over the river Susquehanna, at or near Harrisburg, shall hereafter be "the Harrisburg bridge company," and by the said name shall have all the rights, privileges and franchises, and shall be capable of suing and being sued, and of doing all and every other thing as fully and effectually as under the act to which this act is a supplement, passed the third day of April, one thousand eight hundred and nine, they might or could do, as if the said name, style or title, had not been altered: *Provided,* That nothing herein contained shall in any way affect any of the proceedings of the said company heretofore had, but the same shall remain as valid to all intents and purposes as if this law had not been passed.

SECT. 3. *And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid,* That the time for commencing operations on the York Haven and Harrisburg bridge turnpike road, be and the same is hereby extended for the term of one year, and the time of completing the same, three years, from the passage of this act.

AN ACT
