

subscribed and paid, vest in the commonwealth all the rights, estates and emoluments appertaining to a share or shares held by individual stockholders: *Provided*, The individual stockholders of the stock in the said bridge company, or other new subscribers, shall subscribe, in addition, a sufficient number of shares, of twenty-five dollars each share, to ensure a thorough and permanent repair of the said bridge, of which subscription and payment the Governor shall be satisfied before he subscribes the new stock on the part of the state, as above directed, and the holders of any new stock to be subscribed under the provisions of this act, shall have the same rights and privileges, in proportion to the amount of stock they may subscribe and pay, and shall be subject to all the laws and regulations to which the present stockholders are or may be liable.

### A FURTHER SUPPLEMENT

To an act entitled "A supplement to an act to authorize the Governor of this commonwealth to incorporate a company for the purpose of making and erecting a bridge over the river Susquehanna, in the county of Lancaster, at or near the town of Columbia," passed the twenty-eighth day of March, one thousand eight hundred and nine."

SECT. 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That the president and directors of the Columbia bridge company, may, and are hereby authorized to increase the capital stock of said Columbia bridge company in an amount not exceeding the sum of one hundred thousand

dollars; and that all the provisions and privileges of the act entitled A supplement to an act entitled An act to authorize the Governor of this commonwealth to incorporate a company for the purpose of making and erecting a bridge over the river Susquehanna, in the county of Lancaster, at or near the town of Columbia, passed the twenty-ninth day of March, one thousand eight hundred and twenty-four, be and the same are hereby extended for the term of fifteen years from and after the first Wednesday of May, in the year eighteen hundred and thirty-four.

Governor to subscribe 500 shares.

SECT. 2. *And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid,* That the Governor of this commonwealth be and he is hereby authorized and required to subscribe in the name of this commonwealth, from time to time, as he may be required by the president and directors of the said Columbia bridge company, for any number not exceeding five hundred shares, at one hundred dollars per share, to be paid to said company by warrants drawn by him on the treasury of this commonwealth: *Provided,* That satisfactory evidence shall first have been received by the Governor that the president and directors of said company have received subscriptions, to be applied exclusively to the repairing or rebuilding of said bridge, equal to the amount which they shall ask to be subscribed for on the part of the state; and that upon the number of shares of stock subscribed for by the Governor, like instalments shall be paid as may, from time to time, by the directions of the proper officers of the said company be paid by individual subscribers, and that before the payment of such instalments on the part of the state, satisfactory evidence of the payment of the proportion required of individual subscribers, shall be furnished to the Governor: *Provided further,* That if the said bridge will have to be rebuilt, in such case it shall be so constructed as to enable the Legislature to authorize and direct rails to be laid on the same, for the passage of rail-road cars, such cars to pay such tolls to the said company as may be deemed reasonable and proper, subject to the control of the legislature.

Legislature to elect 2 directors in lieu of State Treasurer and Auditor General.

SECT. 3. *And whereas* the duties required of the State Treasurer and Auditor General, in the discharge of the duty of their offices, renders it impracticable for them to attend to the duty of directors of said company: Therefore, *Be it enacted by the authority aforesaid,* That the Senate and House of Representatives shall, in addition to the number of directors required to be elected by them, elect each one director, in the same manner as directors of said company have heretofore been elected, and that the State Treasurer and Auditor General shall no longer be considered directors of said company:

SECT. 4. *And be it further enacted by the authority afore-* Repealing

*said,* That so much of the aforesaid act as is hereby altered  
and supplied be and the same is hereby repealed.

AN ACT

Authorizing a temporary loan for the payment of the expenses of necessary repairs on the Pennsylvania canal.

SECT. 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That the Governor be and he is hereby authorized to negotiate a temporary loan on the credit of this commonwealth, not to exceed seventy five thousand dollars, at an interest not exceeding five per centum per annum, with any bank or banks, corporation or individuals, as in his opinion may be most advantageous, and the sum or sums so borrowed shall be paid to and vested in the commissioners of the internal improvement fund, to be applied to the payment of the expenses of necessary repairs upon the several lines of the Pennsylvania canal, and the money so borrowed to be repaid to the lender or lenders within six months from the date of this act. \$75,000, payable within six months.
