AN ACT

For the relief of the heirs of John Fitzgerald, a soldier of the revolutionary war.

SECT. 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That the State Treasurer be and he is hereby authorized and required to pay to Jacob Drumheller, in trust for the heirs and legal representatives of John Fitzgerald, two hundred dollars, as compensation for a tract of donation land, to which the said John Fitzgerald became entitled by his revolutionary services. \$200 granted to J. Drumheller in trust.
