## A SUPPLEMENT

To an act authorizing the Governor to incorporate a company for making a turnpike road from the borough of Muncy, through Hillsgrove and Eldredville in Lycoming county, to intersect the Berwick and Newtown turnpike, at or near Towanda Creek, in Monroe township, Bradford county, passed the twenty third day of February, one thousand eight hundred and thirty-one, and for other purposes.

SECT. 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That the president and managers of the Muncy and Towanda turnpike road shall make, or cause the same to be made, not less than twenty-six nor more than fifty feet in width, and at least eighteen feet of said road shall be paved with stone, agreeable to the provisions of the aforesaid act, and that so much of said act as is hereby altered, be, and the same is hereby repealed.

Width and construction of road.

Relative to the no. of directors, president, &c. of the Chambersburg turnpike road company.

SECT. 2. *And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid,* That the number of managers of "The Chambersburg turnpike road company," incorporated by an act of assembly, passed the fourth day of April, one thousand eight hundred and nine, shall be reduced to five, the president included, who shall be elected as heretofore directed, at the next election to be held, of officers of said company, and annually thereafter, a majority of whom shall be a quorum to do business, to elect one of their number president, to appoint all officers and agents as heretofore, and to have, enjoy, and exercise all powers and authorities heretofore exercised by the president and managers of said company.

Charter of Marietta, Richland and Mount Joy turnpike co. annulled.

SECT. 3. *And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid,* That from and after the passing of this act, the charter of the "President, managers and company of the Marietta, Richland and Mountjoy turnpike road," be, and the same is hereby declared to be null and void, and the said managers released from any obligations to keep such road in repair, and are deprived of the benefits of taking or receiving any toll or tolls from travellers for passing said road.

Supervisors to take charge of road.

SECT. 4. *And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid,* That the supervisors of the highways for the township or townships through which said road passed, are hereby enjoined and required to take, and keep in repair

the said road, and they shall be entitled to the same pay, and liable to the same penalties for neglect of duty, as is provided by the existing laws.

### AN ACT

Further to extend the provisions of, "An act relative to the patenting of lands," passed the eighth day of April, one thousand eight hundred and twenty-nine.

SECT. 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That all the provisions of the act entitled "An act relative to the patenting of lands," passed the eighth day of April, Anno Domini, one thousand eight hundred and twenty-nine; And also of the act to extend the provisions of the foregoing act, passed the twenty-first day of March, Anno Domini, eighteen hundred and thirty-one, be and the same are hereby extended, and shall continue in full force and operation for the term of one year from and after the eighth day of April, A. D. one thousand eight hundred and thirty-two. Act of 8th April, 1829, extended another year.

SECT. 2. *And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid,* That the purchasers of undrawn donation lots shall not be required to pay interest on the purchase money on the donation tracts of land, prior to the date of the act authorizing the sale of the said lands or lots, passed the sixth day of March, one thousand eight hundred and thirteen. Interest on the purchase money of undrawn donation lots.
