AN ACT

Authorizing the trustees of the Methodist Episcopal church in the borough of Williamsburg, in the county of Huntingdon, to sell and convey certain real estate.

Preamble.

WHEREAS, Jacob Ake, by his deed, dated the seventeenth day of August, one thousand eight hundred and twelve, granted to the trustees of the Methodist Episcopal church in the borough of Williamsburg, in the county of Huntingdon, a certain lot of ground in said borough, for the purpose of building a house of worship, in trust for the use of said congregation; that the said congregation has increased to such a degree that the said building will no longer conveniently accommodate them, but will very conveniently accommodate the Baptist congregation in said borough, who have purchased the same: Therefore,

SECT. 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That the trustees of the Methodist Episcopal church in the borough of Williamsburg, in the county of Huntingdon, be, and they hereby are authorized to convey by a good and sufficient deed or deeds, according to articles of agreement entered into, to the trustees of the Baptist church of Williamsburg, the house now occupied by said Methodist Episcopal church as a place of worship, together with the lot of ground on which the same is erected: *Provided,* That the said Jacob Ake or his legal representatives assent to said conveyance.

Trustees authorized to convey meeting house to Baptists.

Proviso. Jacob Ake's assent to transfer.
