A SUPPLEMENT

To the act entitled, An act relative to the Pennsylvania canals and rail roads, passed the thirtieth March, one thousand eight hundred and thirty two.

SECT. 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That the canal commissioners be and they are hereby authorized and required to prosecute the works of public improvement heretofore authorized to be put under contract and in part executed, and not comprehended in the act to which this is a supplement, in such manner as to indemnify contractors, and prevent injuries to individuals: *Provided,* That in so doing, they shall not exceed the sum of three hundred thousand dollars; and the said sum of three hundred thousand dollars is hereby specifically appropriated to the said purposes, to be applied to the different divisions of the said works, in such proportions as the canal commissioners may think just, expedient and necessary.

Canal commissioners authorized to continue certain contracts.

Proviso.

Appropriation of \$300,000.

SECT. 2. *And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid,* That the Governor of the commonwealth be and he is hereby authorized to borrow, if necessary, the sum of three hundred thousand dollars, for the purpose of carrying this act into effect, in the same manner and upon the same terms as provided for in the fourth section of the act to which this is a supplement; and the canal commissioners are required to report to the legislature at the next session, what portion of the said three hundred thousand dollars shall have been expended on each of the said improvements.

Governor authorized to negotiate a loan for that amount.

Canal commissioners to report to legislature.
