A SUPPLEMENT

To the act entitled An act to enable the Governor of this commonwealth to incorporate a company for making an artificial road by the best and nearest route from the north eastern branch of the Susquehanna, between the lower Whopehawly and Nescopeck creeks, in Luzerne county, to the north side of Nescohonong creek, near its entrance into the river Lehigh, passed the nineteenth of March, one thousand eight hundred and four.

SECT. 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That the president, managers and company of the Susquehanna and Lehigh turnpike road be, and they are hereby authorized and empowered to make a new road on the north side of the Nescopeck mountain, in the county of Luzerne, beginning at or near the house of John Henry, junior, and thence in a direction so as to avoid Bevilhemer hill, and continuing and intersecting the present road on the top of the said mountain; also to alter or make a new road on the north side of Buck mountain, as will make the ascent more gradual and easy than the present location admits; and any alteration which may be so made, agreeably to this act, shall constitute a part of the said turnpike road as fully and effectually in every respect, as if it was a part of the original location of said turnpike road: *Provided,* That nothing in this act contained, shall be construed to exempt the said company from the payment of damages to private property, as prescribed by the ninth section of the original act, authorizing the incorporation of said company.
