A SUPPLEMENT

To an act entitled, An act authorizing the Governor to incorporate the Lizard creek, Lehigh, and Loyalhanna bridge companies, and for other purposes, passed the first day of April, one thousand eight hundred and thirty-one, and for other purposes.

SECT. 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That the Governor be and he is hereby authorized and required to subscribe, on behalf of this commonwealth, one hundred shares, at twenty-five dollars a share, to the stock of the company for erecting a bridge over the Loyalhanna creek where the northern turnpike crosses the same, one half of the amount of said subscription to be paid as soon as the abutments and piers shall have been erected, and the remainder thereof when the bridge shall be made passable for wagons, on warrants drawn by the Governor on the State Treasurer.

Governor to subscribe \$2500 to the Loyalhanna bridge.

SECT. 2. *And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid,* That certificates of shares to the amount of said subscription shall be delivered to the State Treasurer, and shall vest in the said commonwealth all the rights and emoluments appertaining to a share or shares as held by individual stockholders; and as often as a dividend shall be declared by the managers of the said company, the proportion thereof due to the state shall be paid by said corporation into the treasury of this commonwealth.

Of the certificates of stock and dividends.

SECT. 3. *And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid,* That the aforesaid company are hereby authorized to charge and receive the same tolls as are given and granted to the president, managers and company, for erecting a bridge over the Youghiogheny river at the town of Robbstown, in Westmoreland county, passed the twenty-third day of March, one thousand eight hundred and thirty-one, and its supplements: *Provided,* That all persons going to or returning from public worship, or going to or from military trainings, or going to or from funerals, or children going to or from school, shall be exempt from paying toll.

Same tolls allowed to company as to the Robbstown Youghiogheny bridge.

Proviso. Free passengers.

SECT. 4. *And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid,* That so much of the original act to which this is a supplement as is hereby altered or supplied, be and the same is hereby repealed.

Repealing clause.

SECT. 5. *And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid,* That the Governor be and he is hereby authorized and required to subscribe on behalf of this commonwealth, for

one hundred shares, at twenty dollars each share, in the Franklin bridge company, incorporated for erecting a bridge over French creek at the town of Franklin, to be paid by the State Treasurer on a warrant drawn by the president of said company at any time after the passage of this act, for the purpose of repairing the injuries to said bridge caused by the late freshets, which said sum shall be subject in all respects to former acts relative to said bridge.

SECT. 6. *And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid,* That the Governor of this commonwealth be and he is hereby authorized and required to draw his warrant on the treasurer of this commonwealth, in favor of the superintendent of the gunpowder magazine in the county of Philadelphia, for any sum of money he may require not exceeding six hundred dollars; to be by him applied to the payment of necessary expenses which may be incurred by him in repairing the said magazine, and in doing any thing that may have a tendency to protect the property belonging thereto, and ensure safety to the citizens in the immediate neighborhood thereof, he, the said superintendent having first given satisfactory evidence that the repairs have been made in accordance with this act.

AN ACT

Concerning the administration of justice.

SECT. 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the*
