AN ACT

To provide for defraying certain contingent and other expenses, in the offices of the Auditor General and the Secretary of the Land Office.

SECT. 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That the sum of eight hundred dollars be and is hereby appropriated for clerk hire, in the office of the Auditor General, for one year from the first day of April; one thousand eight hundred and thirty-two; and the sum of one hundred and fifty dollars be and is hereby appropriated, in addition to the sum annually appropriated for the contingent expenses of the said office; and the sum of three hundred dollars be and is hereby appropriated for the contingent expenses of the office of the Secretary of the Land Office.

Entitled, A further supplement to "an act for taking lands in execution,"

Provisions of
