AN ACT

To incorporate the Trustees of the Proprietors of Salem township, in Luzerne county.

SECT. 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met.* and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That all leases, sales and contracts, heretofore made by the committee of the proprietors of the said township of Salem, of and concerning lands originally appropriated to the public use of said township, be and the same are hereby confirmed as fully and amply as though the said committee had been vested with legal titles at the time of making such leases and contracts. Certain leases, sales, &c. confirmed.

SECT. 2. *And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid,* That the second, third, fourth and fifth sections of the act entitled "An act to incorporate the trustees of the proprietors of Kingston, in Luzerne county," passed March the thirtieth, one thousand eight hundred and twenty-two, be and the same are hereby extended to the township of Salem, in Luzerne county. Certain sections of former act extended to Salem.

SECT. 3. *And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid,* That until the election of the officers of the said corporation, John Bidlack, Josiah T. Beach and Alexander Jamieson, the present committee of the proprietors of said township of Salem, shall be vested with the powers of trustees under this act, and any suit or suits already commenced by any committee or committees of said township, may be prosecuted to a final determination, and all judgments already obtained may be recovered by and for the use and at the expense of the said incorporation. Present committee to act as trustees until election.
