A SUPPLEMENT

To the act to incorporate the Reading Academy.

SECT. 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That the sum of three thousand dollars is hereby granted to the trustees of the Reading Academy, in the county of Berks, for the relief of said Academy, to be paid by the State Treasurer, on warrant of the Governor: Provided, That the trustees of said Academy shall cause to be educated annually four students, in indigent circumstances, for the term of five years, (if so many shall apply) free of expense of tuition, in such manner as to qualify them for teachers of common English schools.*

\$3000 appropriated.

Proviso.
Free education of 4 students for 5 years.
