AN ACT

Supplementary to an act entitled "An act supplementary to the act entitled 'An act for the establishment of a college at Canonsburg, in the county of Washington, in the commonwealth of Pennsylvania,' passed the seventh day of April, eighteen hundred and twenty-six.

SECT. 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That from and after the passing of this act, the building in the city of Philadelphia, situated in South Tenth street, and known as the Jefferson Medical College edifice, together with the lot of ground whereon the same is erected, shall be and hereby is declared to be free from taxation for any and all purposes by the city and county of Philadelphia, and for the poor of the same, for and during the term of ten years; provided the said premises shall be so long occupied by the Medical Faculty of Jefferson College, under the direction of the additional trustees of said college; and provided further, the benefit of this exemption from taxes shall annually accrue to the said medical faculty, for the reduction of the rent which they now are or may hereafter be required to pay for the use of said building and lot of ground.

Jeff. Med. college in Philadelphia exempted from taxation for 10 years if so long occupied by the faculty.

To repeal the proviso of the act entitled "An act supplementary to an act relative to the building of certain bridges over the Monongahela and Allegheny rivers, opposite Pittsburg," passed the eighth day of March, Anno Domini, eighteen hundred and thirty-two.

SECT. 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That the proviso of the act entitled "An act supple-

mentary to an act relative to the building of certain bridges ^{Repeal.} over the Monongahela and Allegheny rivers, opposite Pittsburg," passed the eighth day of March, eighteen hundred and thirty-two, be, and the same is hereby repealed.

AN ACT

Dividing the county of Schuylkill into districts for the appointment of justices of the peace.

SECT. 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That the commissioners of the county of Schuylkill shall, on or before the first day of August next, lay off the said county of Schuylkill in suitable districts for the appointment of a competent number of justices of the peace, and when completed, the said commissioners shall, on or before the first day of October next, transmit a duplicate return of the same, in numerical order, of the number of districts contained in said county, describing the bounds of each district, the number of taxable inhabitants and of acting justices within each, and as near as may be the local residence of such justice, and stating also the township or townships, and parts of townships of which each district may be composed, to the office of the Secretary of the Commonwealth; and the said commissioners shall also transmit one other duplicate of the same to the prothonotary of said county, who shall enter the same on record in his office, and shall receive twenty-five cents for each district by him so recorded, to be paid by the county.

SECT. 2. *And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid,* That the said commissioners shall not lay off said county in more than sixteen districts, and that if the said commissioners shall refuse or neglect to do and perform the
