AN ACT

For the relief of John Kroan, John Santee, Thomas Montgomery and Robert Casbolt, soldiers, and Catharine Bonnicks, the widow of a soldier of the revolutionary war.

SECT. 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That the State Treasurer be, and he is hereby authorized and required to pay to John Kroan of York county, John Santee of Northampton county, of this state, and to Robert Casbolt of Greene county, state of Ohio, or to their orders, each forty dollars immediately, and an annuity of forty dollars, payable half yearly, to commence on the first day of January, one thousand eight hundred and thirty-two.

\$40 gratuities and annuities granted to J. Kroan, J. Santee and R. Casbolt.

Same to Catharine Bonnicks.

SECT. 2. *And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid,* That the State Treasurer be, and he is hereby authorized and required to pay to Catharine Bonnicks of York county, the widow of a revolutionary soldier, or to her order, forty dollars immediately, and an annuity of forty dollars, payable half yearly, to commence on the first day of January, one thousand eight hundred and thirty-two.

\$40 gratuity to Tho. Montgomery.

SECT. 3. *And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid,* That the State Treasurer be, and he is hereby authorized and required to pay Thomas Montgomery of Washington county, state of Kentucky, or to his order, a gratuity of forty dollars, as a compensation in full for his revolutionary services.
