SECT. 2. *And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid,* That the State Treasurer is hereby directed to pay to ^{\$60 to M. H.} Michael H. Spangler, brigade inspector of the first brigade, ^{Spangler.} fifth division, Pennsylvania Militia, the sum of sixty dollars as compensation for settling up the accounts of his predecessor.

SECT. 3. *And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid,* That the commissioners of Allegheny county, are hereby authorized and required to draw their warrants on the county treasurer, in favor of Ebenezer Kerr, late a coroner of said county, for the amount of jurors, constables and witnesses fees, paid on coroners inquests held by him in said county, at the rate of one dollar per diem for each juror in each case; and the constables and witnesses fees shall be taxed in conformity with the act of the twenty-second February, eighteen hundred and twenty-one, regulating fees before justices of the peace and constables. Comm'rs. of Allegheny co. authorized to pay certain coroner's fees to E. Kerr.

A SUPPLEMENT

To the act entitled "An act to revive the act incorporating the borough of Greencastle, in the county of Franklin, and for other purposes," passed the twenty-eighth day of March, in the year of our Lord, one thousand eight hundred and twenty.

SECT. 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That from and after the passage of this act, no person or persons who may be elected or appointed to any office, created by the act erecting the town of Greencastle, in the county of Franklin, into a borough, passed the twenty-fifth day of March, in the year of our Lord, one thousand Greencastle Franklin co.

eight hundred and five, shall be compelled to serve for or during a longer period than one year in any term of five years in the same office: and in case the citizens of the said borough of Greencastle, should fail to elect borough officers on the day appointed by law for holding such elections, such failure shall not be deemed to invalidate or render void the charter of said borough, but it shall and may be lawful for the citizens thereof, to hold a new election, for the choice of such officers, at such time and place as they may think proper, giving at least ten days notice of the same, any thing contained in the act to which this is a supplement, to the contrary notwithstanding.

AN ACT

Relative to the real estate of Nathaniel Newlin, deceased, late of Delaware county.

SECT. 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That the Orphans' court of Delaware county be and it is hereby authorized and empowered, upon the application of Cyrus Mendenhall and Thomas Smith, testamentary guardians of the minor grand children of Nathaniel Newlin, late of said county, deceased, if the judges of the said court should be satisfied that a sale of the real estate of said minors, consisting of about eighty acres of land, situated in the township of Darby, in said county, devised to said children by the will of their said grandfather, would be more conducive to the interest of said minors and not injuriously affecting the interest of others, to order and decree a sale and conveyance of the said land, or any part thereof, upon such terms as the court shall direct, for the purpose of paying legacies charged thereon, and maintaining and edu-
