

Term of service, election, &c. of borough officers.

eight hundred and five, shall be compelled to serve for or during a longer period than one year in any term of five years in the same office: and in case the citizens of the said borough of Greencastle, should fail to elect borough officers on the day appointed by law for holding such elections, such failure shall not be deemed to invalidate or render void the charter of said borough, but it shall and may be lawful for the citizens thereof, to hold a new election, for the choice of such officers, at such time and place as they may think proper, giving at least ten days notice of the same, any thing contained in the act to which this is a supplement, to the contrary notwithstanding.

AN ACT

Relative to the real estate of Nathaniel Newlin, deceased, late of Delaware county.

SECT. 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That the Orphans' court of Delaware county be and it is hereby authorized and empowered, upon the application of Cyrus Mendenhall and Thomas Smith, testamentary guardians of the minor grand children of Nathaniel Newlin, late of said county, deceased, if the judges of the said court should be satisfied that a sale of the real estate of said minors, consisting of about eighty acres of land, situated in the township of Darby, in said county, devised to said children by the will of their said grandfather, would be more conducive to the interest of said minors and not injuriously affecting the interest of others, to order and decree a sale and conveyance of the said land, or any part thereof, upon such terms as the court shall direct, for the purpose of paying legacies charged thereon, and maintaining and edu-

AN ACT

To incorporate "The Asbury Beneficial Society of the City and County of
 Philadelphia."

SECT. 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Represen-
 tatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General As-
 sembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the
 same,* That all and every the persons, who shall at the time Corporate
 of the passing of this act, be members of the society, called style.

 Philadelphia," shall be and they are hereby created and de-
 clared to be one body politic and corporate, by the name,
 style and title of "The Asbury Beneficial Society of the Privileges and
