

Article VII. The stated meetings of this society shall ^{Stated meet-} be held monthly, at such time and place as may from time ^{ings, &c.} to time be regulated and declared by the society; and five members shall constitute a quorum for the transaction of business.

Article VIII. By-laws must be proposed at least one month previous to their adoption; and a motion to alter or ^{By-laws.} repeal a by-law must lay over at least one month prior to its being acted upon.

SECT. 3. *And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid,* That nothing in this act contained shall be deemed to authorize the said society to engage, directly or indirectly, in any banking, commercial, mining or manufacturing concerns, or to act in any other way than as a beneficial society ^{To have no other privileges than as a relief society.} for the relief of its respective members.

SECT. 4. *And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid,* That this act shall continue in force ten years from the ^{Term of act 10 years unless sooner annulled.} passing thereof and no longer, for the purposes aforesaid; and the Legislature reserves the right to alter, amend or annul this charter at any time hereafter.

AN ACT

Extending "An act securing to mechanics and others, payment for their labour and materials in erecting any house or other building, within the city and county of Philadelphia," to the counties of Chester, Butler and Perry.

SECT. 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That from and after the passage of this act, the act entitled "An act securing to mechanics and others, payment

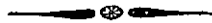

A SUPPLEMENT

To the act entitled "An act to incorporate the Tuscarora and Cold Run tunnel and rail-road company," passed the sixth of April, eighteen hundred and thirty.

SECT. 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That the president, managers and company of the Tuscarora and Cold run tunnel and rail-road company, which will be incorporated under the provisions of the act to which this is a supplement, shall have power to make a rail-road the whole length of the road, or a tunnel in part, as the president, managers and company, may deem most advantageous to the company.

SECT. 2. *And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid,* That the time for commencing the said rail-road and tunnel be extended to three years from and after the passage of this act, and for completing the same to six years from the date of this act, and that so much of the act to which

Company may make a road or tunnel in part.
